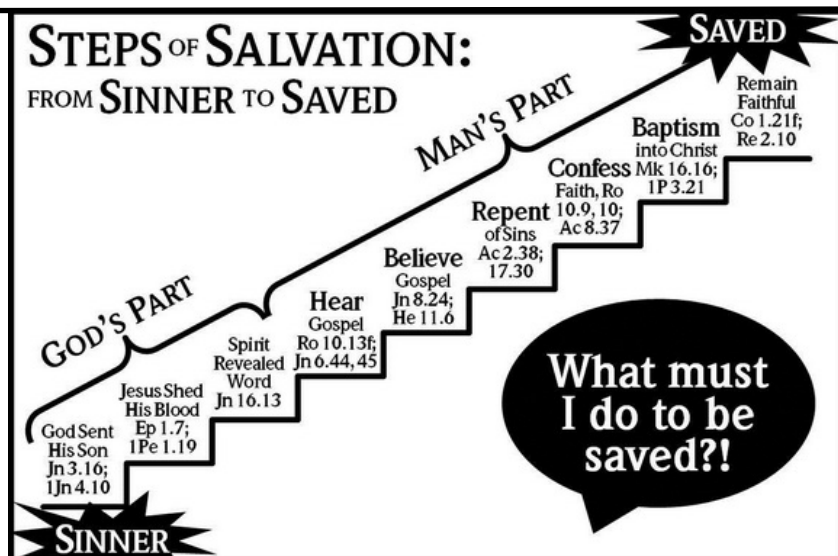
# An Overview of Genesis

Jason Hilburn

1. Genesis means "beginning;" known as the Book of Beginnings (beginnings of the universe, life on earth, family, sin on earth, God's plan for salvation, nations, and the "Messianic nation")
2. The scope is from "the beginning" to "Shiloh" (Gen. 1:1; 49:10).
3. The main divisions are marked by phrases:
  - A. "In the beginning" (Gen. 1:1)
