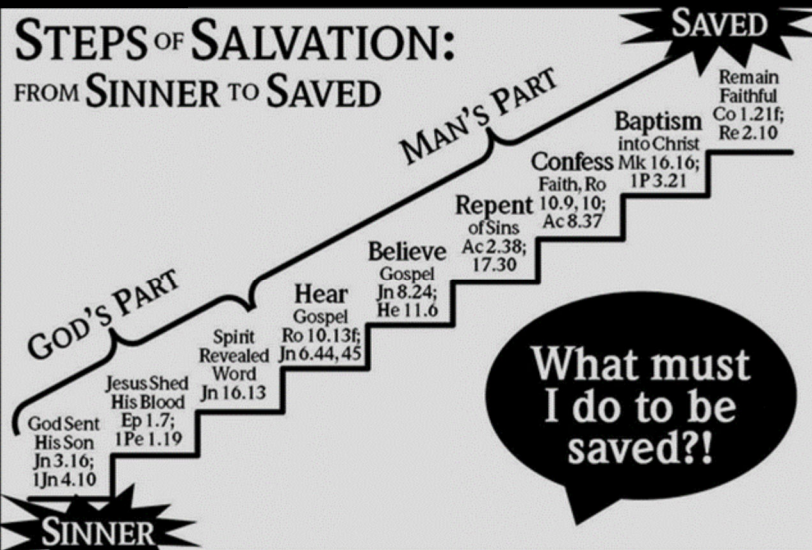

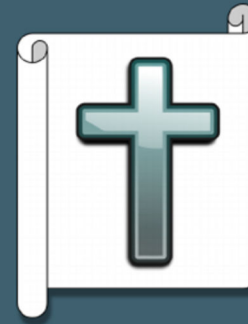
STEPS OF SALVATION: FROM SINNER TO SAVED

God has given the church here some great opportunities to help people in various parts of the world lately! We sent money for 20 Urdu Bibles which were received in Pakistan last week by a denominational preacher Jason is studying with (standing on the left in the picture). The Bibles will be used by this preacher and the congregation there in Kabirwala, Pakistan as Jason continues to study with them, Lord willing. Using the Internet, Jason also

spoke to some Gospel preachers in Pakistan recently for their area preachers' meeting and encouraged them to be strong through the great challenges they are facing.

Also, we recently sent money to supply the funds for a new building for a formerly Pentecostal congregation recently converted in India. The church here also sent money to help a Christian in Cameroon, Africa take care of many Christian refugees staying in his home. He is the director of a preaching school started with the help of Gage Coldwater, and he also asked us to pray for his sick children, Maureen and William. Many have lost homes or died there from the political chaos.

Unreliable, Not in the Bible

The following are some popular teachings that are not taught in the Scriptures:

- **“Follow your heart”** is not in the Bible (Prov. 14:12; 16:25; 30:12; Jer. 10:23; 17:9).
- **“Babies inheriting sin”** is not in the Bible (2 Sam. 12:23; Ezek. 18:20; 28:15; Matt. 18:3; 19:14).
- **“Choose the church of your choice”** is not in the Bible (Matt. 16:18; 1 Cor. 1:10-13; 12:13; Eph. 4:4; 5:23).
- **“Faith only salvation”** is not in the Bible (Matt. 7:21-23; Rom. 6:16-18; Heb. 5:9; 1 Pet. 1:22; James 2:14-26; 1 Jn. 2:3-6).
- **“The [alien] sinner’s prayer for salvation”** is not in the Bible (1 Pet. 3:12, 21; cf. Prov. 28:9; Jn. 9:31).
- **“Water baptism is not for salvation, but is merely an outward sign of an inward faith”** is not in the Bible (Acts 2:38; 22:16; Gal. 3:27; Col. 2:11-13; 1 Pet. 3:20, 21).
- **“Sprinkling as baptism”** is not in the Bible (Jn. 3:23; Acts 8:38; Rom. 6:3-5; Col. 2:12).
- **“Once saved, always saved”** is not in the Bible (2 Cor. 6:1; Gal. 1:6; 5:4; 1 Tim. 4:16; 2 Pet. 2:20-22; Heb. 3:12-14; 4:1, 11; 10:23-31; 12:15-17; James 5:19, 20; Rev. 22:19).
- **“Communion monthly, quarterly, or yearly”** is not in the Bible (Acts 2:42; 20:6, 7; 1 Cor. 11:20; cf. 16:2).
- **“There are many roads to Heaven”** is not in the Bible (Matt. 7:21-23; Jn. 8:31, 32; 14:6; Acts 4:12; Rom. 16:17; 1 Cor. 1:10-13; Heb. 5:9).
- **“Jesus will reign on earth for 1000 years”** is not in the Bible (Jer. 22:28-30; Zech. 6:12, 13; Jn. 5:27-29; 6:39; 11:24; 12:48; 1 Thess. 4:13 — 5:3; Heb. 8:4).
- **“A resurrection and secretive rapture of the saints before seven years of tribulation”** is not in the Bible (Jn. 5:27-29; 6:39; 11:24; 12:48; Acts 24:15; 1 Thess. 4:13 — 5:3).
- **“Worship God any way you want, as long as you are sincere”** is not in the Bible (Gen. 4:3-7; Lev. 10:1-3; Matt. 15:9; Jn. 4:23, 24; Col. 2:23; 3:16, 17; Heb. 11:4; 1 Jn. 3:12).

If I Refuse to Assemble

Faithfully assembling with other members of the Lord’s church in one’s area is commanded and demanded by God (Hebrews 10:23-31; cf. Acts 2:42; 20:6, 7; 1 Cor. 16:1, 2, etc.). There are times when Christians are unable to attend, but if I could be there and choose not to attend, I am:

- Denying God the kind of worship He desires and deserves (Psa. 18:3; John 4:23, 24; 1 Cor. 11:17-20, 33; 14:23; Rev. 4:11).
- Disobeying God’s command to assemble, thereby disassembling the body of Christ (Heb. 10:25).
- Disobeying God’s command to *“hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering”* (Heb. 10:23).
- Disobeying God’s command to encourage other children of God who have assembled (Heb. 10:25).
- Disobeying God’s command to provoke others to love (Heb. 10:24).
- Disobeying God’s command to provoke others to do good works (Heb. 10:24).
- Disobeying God’s command to sing with the other saints to the Lord (Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16).
- Disobeying God’s command to teach and admonish other saints in song (Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16).
- Disobeying God’s command to give on the first day of every week (1 Cor. 16:1, 2; 2 Cor. 9:7; cf. Luke 21:1-4; 2 Cor. 8, 9).
- Disobeying God’s command to partake of the Lord’s Supper on the first day of every week with the local body of Christ (Matt. 26:26, 27; Acts 20:6, 7; 1 Cor. 11:17-20, 24-26, 33; 14:23; cf. 16:2).
- Depriving and weakening the local church by removing my talents, money, and encouragement (Matt. 25:24-30).
- Depriving myself of the best opportunities for spiritual growth (Matt. 5:6; Acts 2:42; 1 Cor. 3:1, 2; Eph. 4:14, 15; 2 Tim. 2:2; Heb. 5:12-14; 1 Pet. 2:2, 3; 2 Pet. 1:5-13; 3:15-18).
- Displaying an attitude of ingratitude (Matt. 26:28; Luke 17:11-18; Col. 3:15).
- Displaying a lack of love for God (Matt. 22:37; 1 Jn. 2:3-6, 15-17; 5:3).
- Displaying a lack of love for others (Matt. 22:39; John 13:34, 35; Php. 2:1-4; 1 Jn. 2:9).
- Displaying a sinful example for others to follow (1 Jn. 2:10; cf. Matt. 5:16).
- Discouraging faithful Christians who are trying their best to get to Heaven and bring others with them (Num. 32:6, 7; Gal. 6:1; Heb. 5:9; James 5:19, 20).
