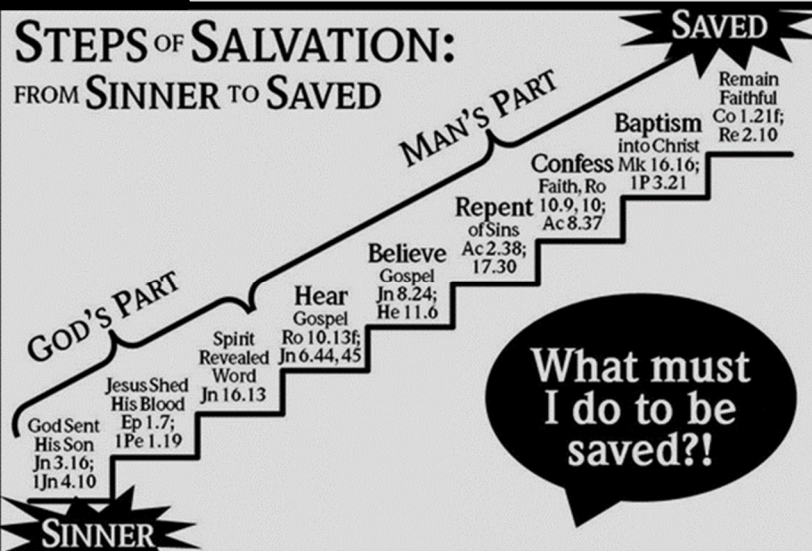

 (Romans 6:17).



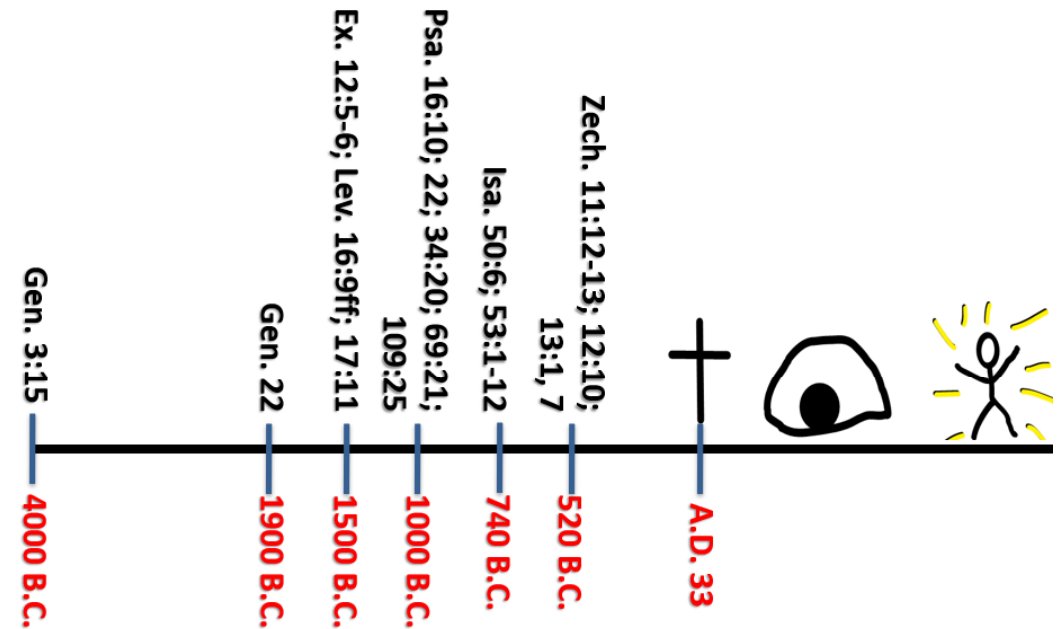
What must I do to be saved?!
