



- * Baptism is a BURIAL in water. (Read Romans 6:3-4; Acts 8:36-39)

- * "Faith ONLY and Baptism is IRRELEVANT" is not a Bible doctrine, and you CAN fall from grace. (Read James 2:24; Galatians 5:4)

Question: If grace is from God, how can we grow in it? (2 Peter 3:18)

The word "grace" (from the Greek word *charis*) does not always mean "the unmerited favor God has shown to man by saving him from Hell." The word "grace" must be defined by context, just like works, spirit, body, law, faith, and many other words. Sometimes "grace" refers to a gift given from one man to another (translated as "pleasure" in Acts 24:27; 25:9). Sometimes grace is related to miraculous gifts God gave men in the first century A.D. "Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith" (Romans 12:6; cf. 12:3; 15:15-19; Eph. 4:7-16). Very often "grace" refers to thanks, thankfulness, or gratitude. For example, the Greek word for the giving of thanks in communion is eucharisteo (Can you see charis in the middle of that word?; 1 Cor. 11:24). To your question, we should grow in gratitude toward God as we remember that all our sins have been forgiven, and all the ways we have been blessed (James 1:17). The word "thanks" in the following verse is from charis: "Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift" (2 Corinthians 9:15). Let us grow in our thankfulness, our gratitude, toward God. Of course, Christians should also want to grow in favor with God by growing in knowledge and making ourselves more and more like Christ daily. —Jason Hilburn
