

Following are some slides from our Acts class, along with an image shared online about a church of Christ which began meeting in 1669, well before Alexander Campbell was even born. It was years after I became a Christian that I first heard about Alexander Campbell, and those who taught me never said a word about Alexander Campbell or his teachings. That is because we follow Christ! Although I appreciate faithful efforts made by Christians who lived before me, I have zero interest in following men. All faithful Christians I know would say the same The verse that is in the very center of the Bible states, "It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man" (Psalm 118:8).

FIRST CENTURY A.D. TEMPORARY OR UNIQUE EVENTS SURROUNDING THE ACCOUNT OF STEPHEN IN ACTS 7

The miraculous power of the Holy Spirit was potentially available to any convert during the days of the early church (temporarily), as the fulfillment of Joel 2:28, 29:

Those Who Believed/Obeyed the Gospel	Could Receive Miraculous Power (no longer available – Zech. 13; 1 Cor. 13; Eph. 4)	
"He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned"	"And these signs shall follow them that believe" (Mark 16:16, 17; cf. 16:18-20).	
"He that believeth on me"	"out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should <u>receive</u> : for the Holy Ghost was not yet <u>given</u> " (Jn. 7:38, 39).	
"Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins"	"and ye shall <u>receive</u> the <u>gift</u> of the Holy Ghost" (Acts 2:38; cf. Lk. 24:49; 2:16-21, 33).	
"to them that obey him"	"God hath given" "the Holy Ghost" (Acts 5:32).

EXCEPTION - ORDER IS REVERSED IN ACTS 10, but Acts 8 teaches that salvation and "receiving the Holy Ghost" were separate events (8:12-18). In Acts 10 the two events are also separate, distinct	"poured out the <u>gift</u> of the Holy Ghost, for they heard them speak with tongues <u>received</u> the Holy Ghost" (Acts 10:45-47).	
"Have ye <u>received</u> the Holy Ghost?" "When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus"	"And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied" (Acts 19:2-6).	

This was the meeting house for the Totelbank church of Christ in England, founding date of congregation 1669. They referred to themselves as the church of Christ, were Christians only, took the Lord's Supper every sunday and were self governing with it's own Elders and Deacons and they baptized by full immersion. This is known by a well preserved minute book of the church meetings. Great piece of church history! This was long before the American Restoration Movement!
