



On Friday, December 3, 2021 in Pakistan a man was tortured, killed, and had his body burned in public by a huge, angry mob of Muslims who believed rumors about the man's alleged "blasphemy." Faithful Christians there like Khokhar Shahid do not know who may be next.

There are also Christians in Africa, Afghanistan, Vietnam, China, and other places where the government is very strict or persecution from peers is very prevalent. I'm asking my Christian friends to pray diligently for those in areas like these, especially our brothers and sisters in Christ, and if you live in a free nation like the USA, be thankful!

From an overseas news source: "...the reason for the factory workers protest [was] the removal of a poster with the name of Prophet Muhammad in Islam...Mob attacks on people accused of blasphemy are common in this Islamic nation...Charges of blasphemy carry the death penalty under Pakistani law. International and Pakistani rights groups say accusations of blasphemy have often been used to intimidate religious minorities and settle personal scores. Friday's attack comes less than a week after a Muslim mob burned a police station and four police posts in northwestern Pakistan, after officers refused to hand over a mentally unstable man accused of desecrating Islam's holy book, the Quran. Pakistan's government has long been under pressure to change the country's blasphemy laws, something the Islamists strongly resist. A Punjab governor was shot and killed by his own guard in 2011, after he defended a Christian woman, Aasia Bibi, who was accused of blasphemy. She was acquitted after spending eight years on death row and, following threats, left Pakistan for Canada to join her family."
