

Did Peter and Paul Preach Two Different Gospels?

Galatians 2:7 - But contrariwise, when they saw that the gospel of the uncircumcision was committed unto me, as the gospel of the circumcision was unto Peter

I've seen many "preachers" really butcher the text above...

Many denominational folks believe this indicates that Paul preached a different gospel than Peter... they do this in attempts to "remove" the plain obligation of baptism from God's plan...

They say that Peter's requirement of baptism was a Jewish ritual, yet Paul taught "salvation by faith alone"

Please consider the following:

1. In Gal. 2:7, here is the actual text without any ADDITIONAL words supplied by translators:

But contrariwise, when they saw that the gospel of the uncircumcision was committed unto me, as of the circumcision unto Peter

- In this text, inspiration is NOT saying that there are 2 distinct "gospels"; rather, there were efforts made via the ONE gospel to BOTH Jew and Gentile... Peter's main audience was Jews (though he did convert gentiles-Acts 10) and Paul's main audience was gentiles (though he did convert Jews-Acts 28)

Each nation was taught EXACTLY the same thing (cf. Acts 2,8,10)

2. Notice that in the same context, Paul very clearly states that the SAME gospel was preached to both Jew and gentile-

Gal 2:2 And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them that

gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.

- 3. The belief that Paul taught "salvation by faith alone" couldn't be more erroneous
- He taught that obedience to the gospel is the only way to obtain salvation- Rom. 1:5,16-17,6:3-5, 16-18, 16:26
- That there is only ONE gospel- Gal. 1:6-9, 2:16
- That man becomes the "son of God" via baptism Gal. 3:26-27
- That baptism is WHEN God forgives us of sin- Col. 2:11-13
- That we are expected to obey, just as Abraham was- Rom. 4:3-12
- That we are to "work out our own salvation"- Phil. 2:12, cf. v13, Gal. 5:6, Eph. 6:6

Editor's Note: We appreciate the article above, and another point is that Jesus commanded "every creature" in "all nations" to become saved by hearing and being baptized—not just Israel.

"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost" (Matthew 28:19).

"And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned" (Mark 16:15-16).

"And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem" (Luke 24:47; cf. Acts 2:38).
