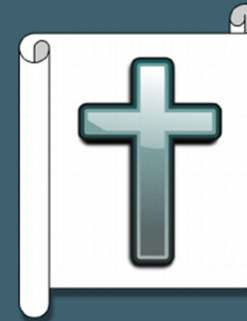

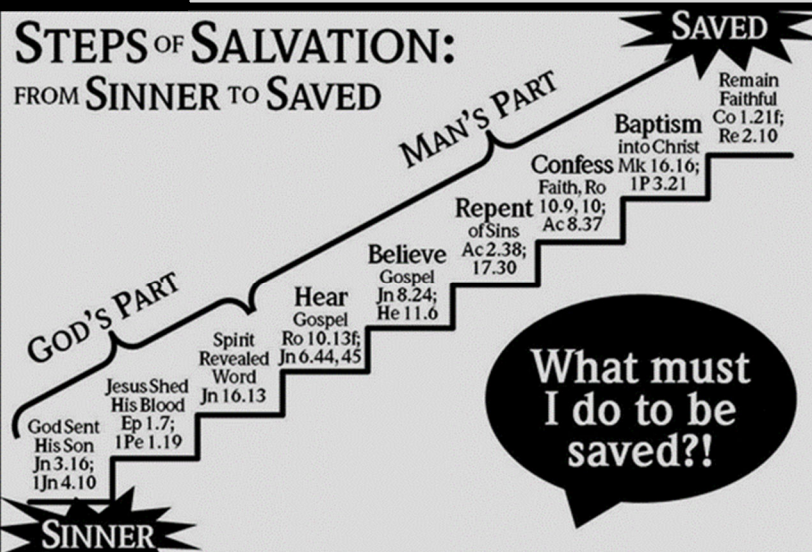
A Few Words from Jason

We have two new sisters in Christ in Pakistan! Their names are Anmon and Anita. They have been attending our weekly online classes and learning a lot of new things from the Scriptures. One of these ladies left a "Pentecostal" denomination, and the other left Catholicism. Neither one had been baptized the way the Bible says, so they were baptized into Christ for the forgiveness of their sins and added to the Lord's church He promised to build (Matt. 16:18; Acts 2:37-41, 47). We are also very excited to announce that a new Bible school has begun in India! *Twin States Bible School* is under the oversight of the Miyapur church of Christ in Hyderabad, India. Classes began in January and will take place one week per month, Monday-Friday. The students (male and female) travel and stay in the area for that week before going back home. Most of the male students sleep in the local church building where the classes are conducted. There are 3 married couples, and each of these couples stayed in church members' houses. There are 3 unmarried young ladies who travel back home every night. Although there is only capacity for about 30 to 35 students, about 75 signed up to attend. Brother Vandan Kumar of the Miyapur congregation is requesting more funds and trying to enable more students to attend. Please keep praying for this exciting new work.
