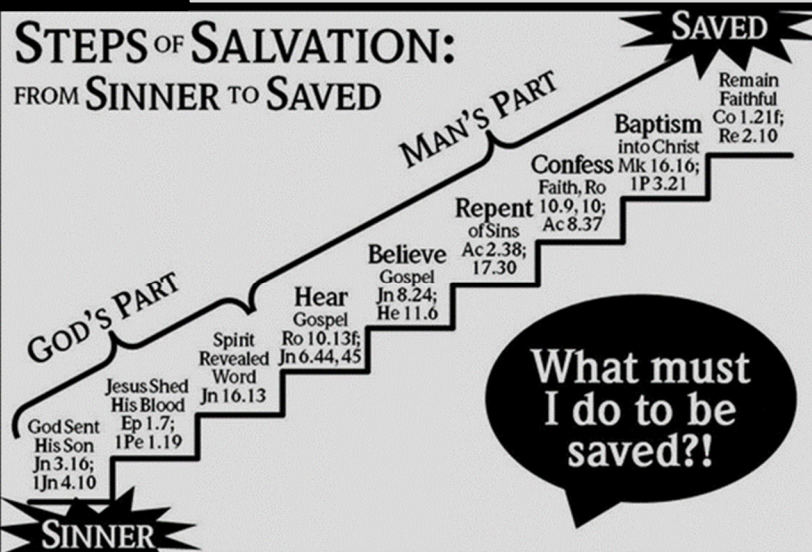

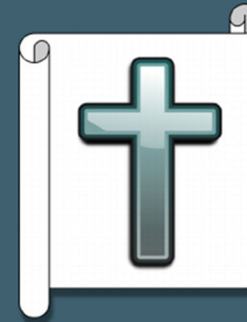

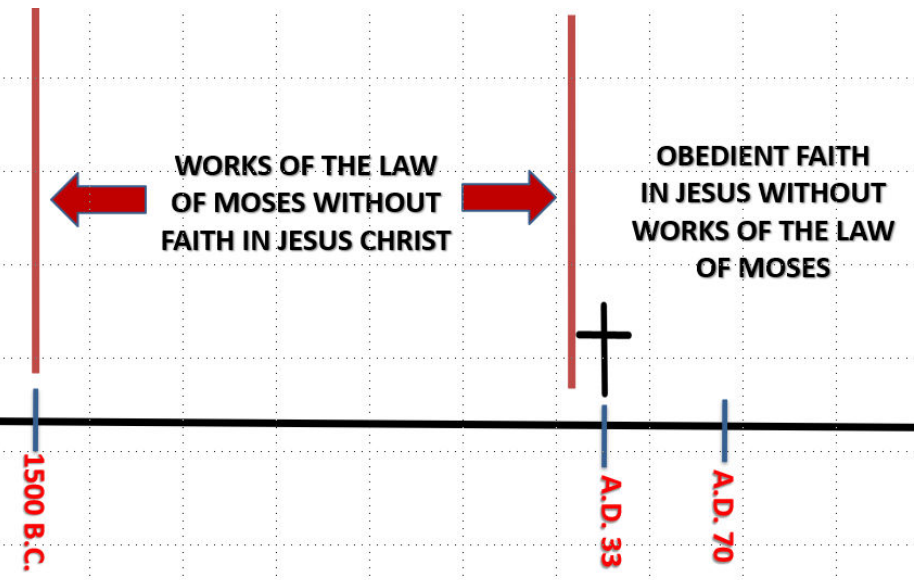

A Few Words from Jason

Following are some slides from the most recent sermon series called "Understanding Ephesians 2:8, 9." Keep in mind this is only 5 slides out of 70. Ephesians 2 is surely one of the most misunderstood and misused passages in all of God's Word. Falsehoods about salvation are the most deadly, and all of us need to make sure we understand how to harmonize passages like Acts 2:38-40 with Ephesians 2:8, 9. At the cross, the Law of Moses came to a screeching halt, which was very hard for many Jews to accept.

Ephesus was near Galatia, where false teachers had been binding works of the Law of Moses for salvation (Gal. 2:15-21; 3:24-29; 5:2-6).



How do we harmonize these passages?
Something critical is missing in the middle!

Acts 2	Ephesians 2

The Great Commission (Mk. 16:15, 16) began in Jerusalem (Acts 2) and would later be taken to Ephesus (Acts 19).

Acts 2:38-40 was addressing **LOST** people, but Ephesians 2 was to **SAVED** people (Acts 19:5)
