



A Few Words from Jason

We are excited to have Jared preaching our meeting, and the topic is a very interesting one that will surely benefit us all. I am confident that our faith will be strengthened this week, if the Lord wills for time to continue.

Again this week I am including slides from our recent sermon series on the Book of Daniel in the bulletin. This week has slides regarding the Hebrew and Aramaic languages found in the Bible, noting that a great deal of Daniel was written in Aramaic, and there guite a few Aramaic words in the New Testament.

Loving Jesus Equals Obedience

Jason Patrick Hilburn

Did Jesus emphasize obedience to His commands, or simply believing in Him and trusting that "faith alone" will be enough? The following words are all from the same discourse to His disciples. Notice how He ties love with obedience: "If ye love me, keep my commandments...He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him...If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings... If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love... Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you" (John 14:15, 21, 23, 24; 15:10, 14; see also Mt. 7:21-27; Lk. 6:46-49; Acts 10:35; Rom. 6:1-18; Gal. 5:6; Heb. 5:9; Jam. 1:21-25; 2:14-26; 1 Pet. 1:15, 16, 22; 1 Jn. 1:6; 2:3-6; 5:3; Jude 21, etc.).

Hebrew and Aramaic

- Aram was a son of Shem (Gen. 10:22), and his name later became synonymous with Syria (see "Syriac" in Dan. 2:4).
- While the Jews were in captivity, their language began to change from Hebrew to Aramaic.
- Most of the Old Testament is in Hebrew, but 269 verses are in Aramaic, including parts of Ezra and Daniel 2:4b 7:28.
- There are some Aramaic words in the New Testament also:
- Talitha cumi, meaning "Damsel, arise" (Mark 5:41)
- Ephphatha, meaning "Be opened" (Mark 7:34)
- Abba, meaning "Father" (Mark 14:36; Rom. 8:15; Gal. 4:6)
- Raca, meaning "fool" (Matthew 5:22)
- Rabboni, meaning "Master" or "teacher" (John 20:16)
- Eli Eli lama sabachthani, meaning "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:46)
- Hosanna, meaning "Lord, save us" (Mark 11:9)
- Maranatha, meaning "Lord, come!" or "the Lord comes" (1 Corinthians 16:22)
