

Why would Egypt willingly let go of Canaan and...


- Lose their intimidating reputation and fame?
- Lose military advantage (give up their Eastern flank)?
- Lose control of Mediterranean sea ports (Gaza, Joppa)?
- Lose control of major trade routes along the coast?
- Lose the tribute/wealth of Canaanite city-states?

Egypt would never give up Canaan under normal circumstances!

The plagues and the Exodus crippled Egypt, and this is confirmed by the Amarna Tablets!

STEPS OF SALVATION: FROM SINNER TO SAVED

"...ye were the servants of sin..."
(Romans 6:17).



"...but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness" (Rom. 6:17b-18).

AMAZING THINGS ALSO HAPPENED AFTER THE PLAGUES

1. Egyptians willingly gave their riches to the Israelites: “Now the children of Israel had done according to the word of Moses, and they had asked from the Egyptians articles of silver, articles of gold, and clothing. And **the LORD had given the people favor in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they granted them what they requested.** Thus they plundered the Egyptians” (Ex. 12:35-36).

2. Many Egyptians joined the Israelites: “And the children of Israel journeyed from Rameses to Succoth, about six hundred thousand on foot that were men, beside children. **And a mixed multitude went up also with them;** and flocks, and herds, even very much cattle” (Ex. 12:37-38; cf. 9:20; 12:48-49; Num. 11:4; Dt. 5:14).

3. Archaeological evidence proves that Egypt worshiped only one god shortly after the plagues and the Exodus!

“EVIDENCE OF THE EXODUS” SUMMARY

- The plagues discredited Egyptian religion and power.
- The plagues identified and glorified the one true God.
- Egypt worshiped only one god after the Exodus.
- Egypt returned to polytheism and never regained the same level of dominance it had before the Exodus.
- Jericho shows a sudden destruction as the Bible records.
- The Amarna Tablets confirm the Hebrew conquest of Canaan and Egypt’s complete inability to intervene.
- The Exodus is not a myth — it is history; it is Truth.
